

### **UPDATE Regarding BOH guidance**

As of May 12, 2020, the Board of Health is now requiring everyone that has been in direct contact with another positive staff or individual in a group home setting will need to be tested.

Further clarification from BOH recommendation: If you have been tested as part of a quarantined home situation and your results are negative, you may still only work in quarantine programs for the duration of the house quarantine as there is an incubation time that must be considered.

Further clarification as of May 7, 2020: If you are in a home that is quarantined and you have been exposed to another positive staff or individual, you are not “quarantined” in the community as long as you remain symptom free, check fever twice daily. You may continue to work in quarantined homes only until quarantine is lifted.

Reiterating: Masks must be worn AT ALL TIMES when working in BCARC programs.
